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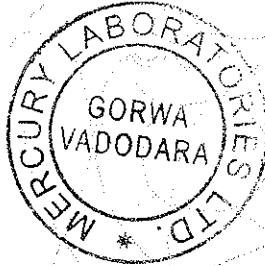


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NOTES ON AUDITED FINANCIAL RESULTS :

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

1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Unaudited Standalone Financial Results of Mercury Laboratories Limited (" the Company") for the quarter ended June 30, 2018 (" the Statement"), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulations 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016. This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indan Accounting Standards 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" as prescribed under Section 133 of Companies Act 2013 (" the Act") read with relevant rules issued there under and other accounting principles generally accepted in India.
